### Job Summary

Under direction of the research coordinator and/or principal investigator, the Clinical Research Nurse is responsible for collecting data for a pre-established research study from patients in various settings.

### Accountabilities

1. Interview and assess patients to determine eligibility for participation in the research study.
2. Inform patient and family about study protocols and procedures.
3. Follow prescribed research methodology to ensure all research material is handled in accordance with established protocols, policies, and procedures.
4. Conduct and process study specific health assessments of patients and ensure accurate collection of relevant data.
5. Document and maintain patient consult notes, assessments, drug accountability logs, charts, and histories on each patient.

### Qualifications

#### Education:

- Bachelor's degree in Nursing.
- Must be registered and maintain annual registration with the College of Nurses of Ontario as a Registered Nurse.

#### Experience:

- Previous experience in the clinical area and knowledge of research principles and practices.

### Working Conditions

- Work is often conducted in hospital or patient home setting.
- May require intermediate periods of moderate physical activity while assessing patients.
- Work is completed under general guidance and direction.
