Job Summary

Provide support to a research project by collecting field samples, conducting experiments, and performing basic data analysis. Work is performed under general direction and guidance.

Accountabilities

- 1. Conduct field surveys and collect field samples for experimental research.
- 2. Work with the Research Coordinator and/or Principle Investigator to gather, summarize and compile data.
- 3. Conduct research experiments, observe details and keep accurate records of experiments and results.
- 4. Summarize data and prepare technical reports based on research findings.
- 5. Attend and participate in research group meetings.
- 6. Prepare samples for analyses.
- 7. Seek guidance and direction from Research Staff or Manager.

Qualifications

Education: Currently enrolled in a relevant post-secondary program.

Experience: No minimum experience required.

Working Conditions

- Work is performed under close supervision.
- Frequently works outside in a range of weather conditions.
- Frequently required to wear personal protective equipment such as boots, glasses, hard hats, and personal floatation devices.
- Occasionally exposed to dirt and dust.
