FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQS)

What kind of bus is being pulled?

Teams will be pulling a Marauder shuttle bus.

How far is the bus being pulled?

The bus is being pulled 100 feet.

What if I wish to participate, but I cannot pull a bus?

Teams are welcome to have “coaches” above and beyond the maximum number of twelve participants, who do not have to pull the bus. There is also plenty to do for those who would like to attend and support! There will also be lunch available for purchase, with all ticket sales going to the United Way.

Can a team fundraise more than \$300?

Yes! In fact, we encourage you to do so!

How does our team submit our pledges?

Pledges will also be able to be submitted **online** by use of credit card. This online function will be made available on August 22nd.

Where does our fundraising money go?

Every dollar submitted by participants will go directly to the United Way of Halton & Hamilton

Does the team captain have a larger role than the rest of the team?

The team captain is the only individual who will be registering their team online. Once they register themselves, the organizer will send a link for the captain to share with their teammates. The teammates will use this link to register. In addition to this, captains will also be the main point of communication with the Bus Pull Organizing Committee.

I do not have a team – can I still register for this event?

Yes! There will be an option to register as an individual. All individual registrants will be placed in a Community Team. Individual registration is \$30.

Do I have to arrive before 11:30 a.m. if I am participating in the Bus Pull?

Teams will be required to arrive at least 15 minutes prior to their heat time. All teams will be notified of their heat time one week prior to the event.

Do I need to stay for the entire event?

No. You are welcome to stay for as long as you wish! There will be food and entertainment for all to enjoy as well.

How will my team know when it is their turn?

Every team captain will be informed of their heat time one week prior to the event.

How are we judged on spirit?

While not mandatory, Spirit is judged on costumes, team cheers, sportsmanship, and overall positive attitude towards the event.

What if it rains?

This event will be occurring rain or shine! Should we experience extreme weather, we will work to postpone the event to another date.
